Bond Measures

The Board of Trustees of the Las Lomitas Elementary School District is seeking qualified, interested individuals to serve on a committee of community leaders which will serve as the Independent Citizens' Oversight Committee ("COC") for the implementation of the District's school facilities bond program.

Proposition 39 Bond Election

On November 5, 2013, voters residing within the Las Lomitas Elementary School District passed Measure S. Measure S is a \$60 million bond measure that authorizes funding for needed repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to the District's schools. In addition, on June 5, 2018, voters passed Measure R. Measure R is a \$70 million bond measure continuing to fund the school facilities bond program.

Establishment of a Citizens' Oversight Committee

After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, state law requires that the Las Lomitas Elementary School District Board of Trustees appointed a Citizens' Oversight Committee to work with the District.

Committee Responsibilities

In accordance with Education Code Section 15278(b), the Citizens' Oversight Committee shall:

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of bond proceeds;
- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in measures; and
- Present to the Board of Trustees in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of bond proceeds.

The Bylaws which govern the Citizens' Oversight Committee are attached to this Application.

Appointment of Committee Members

All appointments will be made by the Board of Trustees from applications submitted to the District.

Time Commitment and Term

Appointments will be for an initial two-year term and will be eligible for reappointment by the Board of Trustees for a second and third two-year term.
