JOB DESCRIPTION

MAINTENANCE WORKER

BASIC FUNCTION:

Under the direction of the Supervisor-Maintenance, Operations & Transportation, perform a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled maintenance, repair and construction duties involving designated facilities, utilities and equipment; assist other maintenance personnel in the performance of a variety of duties related to the building trades.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled maintenance, repair and construction duties in the maintenance of designated facilities, utilities and equipment; assist in assuring a safe environment for students and staff.
- Assist skilled maintenance workers in various skilled trades including HVAC, carpentry, plumbing, electrical, glazing, painting and others as assigned.
- Inspect school grounds and buildings for health and safety hazards; inspect and maintain fire exits and extinguishers as required.
- Assist in installing, maintaining and repairing heating, ventilation, air conditioning and refrigeration systems as directed; maintain gas and water lines; replace filters and unclog drains as necessary.
- Schedule and perform preventive maintenance of systems, including HVAC systems, water supply, electrical supply and plumbing
- Repair and refurbish cabinets, bookcases and a variety of classroom equipment; install and repair floor and ceiling tiles, roofs and shelving.
- Assist in alterations, repairs and construction of articles and structures of wood such as partitions, counters, forms and fences.
- Assist in installing and repairing electrical systems as assigned; install, maintain and replace light bulbs, wiring and fixtures.
- Perform general plumbing and irrigation repairs as directed; assist with installing, repairing and maintaining fixtures, toilets and sinks; assist with water and gas line repairs; unclog drains.
- Perform preventive maintenance on equipment such as troubleshooting, repairing or replacing switches, receptacles, valves, belts and motors; maintain fans, thermostats and pumps; assist with repairs to bells, clocks, lighting circuits and other equipment.
- Confer and collaborate with the Supervisor-Maintenance, Operations & Transportation and site administrators in planning systematic maintenance, including interior/exterior painting, roof repairs, and other items requiring periodic maintenance.
- Review and prioritize work orders; expedite routine maintenance requests; estimate labor and materials
 needed for projects; work from oral and written instructions and work orders; respond to emergency repair
 needs as requested.
- Schedule maintenance for maintenance and operations vehicles; drive a vehicle to conduct work.
- Operate and maintain a variety of maintenance equipment including a variety of hand and power tools; maintain equipment in clean and orderly condition
- Maintain routine records related to assigned activities.

OTHER DUTIES:

• Perform related duties as assigned.

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REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Education and Experience:

• Any combination equivalent to: graduation from high school and one year performing a variety of maintenance work in one or more of the building maintenance trades.

Valid California Class C driver's license.

Knowledge of:

- Standard tools, equipment, materials, methods and techniques used in general construction, maintenance and repair.
- Operation and proper maintenance of tools, equipment and machinery used in the building trades.
- Operation of a computer and assigned software.
- Basic preventive maintenance principles and practices.
- Requirements of maintaining buildings in a safe, clean and orderly condition.
- Read, interpret and work from drawings and blueprints.
- Tools, materials and terminology used in the various trades including carpentry, plumbing,
- Appropriate safety precautions and procedures.
- Oral and written communication skills.
- Basic record-keeping techniques.
- Proper lifting techniques.

Ability to:

- Perform a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled maintenance, repair and construction duties in the maintenance of designated facilities, utilities and equipment.
- Assist in assuring a safe environment for students and staff.
- Assist other maintenance personnel in the performance of a variety of duties related to the building trades.
- Operate a variety of assigned tools and equipment used in various maintenance trades effectively and safely.
- Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- Learn and apply laws, rules, regulations involved in assigned maintenance activities.
- Work independently with little direction.
- Perform heavy manual labor.
- Understand and follow oral and written directions.
- Observe health and safety regulations.
- Meet schedules and time lines.
- Maintain routine records.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Work Environment:

- Indoor/Outdoor work environment.
- Regular exposure to fumes, dust and odors.
- Seasonal heat and cold or adverse weather conditions.
- Driving a vehicle to conduct work.
